



# Best-selling author shines the limelight on InRETURN

A non-profit group in Blue Ash that employs people suffering from brain injuries, strokes and autism is about to hit the publishing big-time.

InRETURN, an organization formed in 2004 with a plant on Interstate Circle, will be featured in Heart & Soul: Five American Companies That Are Making The World A Better Place.

The book, to be released in September, is authored by Robert Shook, who has written five New York Times' bestsellers and whose books have been discussed on "60 Minutes," "Larry King Live" and "Good Morning America."

InRETURN founder Rob Groeschen of Loveland had a straightforward and personal reason for creating the organization: He wanted to employ his brain-damaged brother, Tom Groeschen, who was injured in a car wreck in 1983 and having trouble keeping a job. That act of brotherly love has turned out to be a source of livelihood and dignity for dozens of others with special needs.

At InRETURN, Tom Groeschen and his fellow employees perform outsourcing work from businesses, including assembling products, sorting and packaging items and preparing bulk mail.

They sell greeting cards and absorbent products made of recycled material for cleaning up spills. They also evaluate businesses' recycling needs and implement recycling plans at manufacturing plants.

InRETURN supports the employees with guidance and life-skills training.

"We promote independent living and personal success by providing real-world employment in a work environment that includes resources for guidance and training in everyday life skills, community involvement, financial independence, socialization and continued education," said Jill Gorley of Deerfield Township, director of InRETURN.
